FREE COMPUTER COURSES FOR ADULTS!

Kajima Community and Haverstock School, along with the delivery team WEA have teamed up to put on a number of FREE exciting computer courses for the local community.



The courses available are:

BEGINNERS: AN INTRODUCTION TO COMPUTERS for those who are new to computers or who have not used one for a long time. On this course learners will get to find their way around a computer, create a document and use the internet to access websites and send email. Beginners Courses take place each Tuesday from 4.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

Maximum number of places available for this course – 15

ADVANCED CLASS: CLAIT. A limited number of places are available on this established course. To qualify learners must be able to use the computer and be familiar with Microsoft Office packages. This is an OCR accredited course which can lead to a CLAIT qualification, designed to recognise the skills, knowledge and understanding of IT users. Advanced Classes take place each Monday from 3.45 – 6.15 p.m.

TANGO

Since Corrientes Social Club, www.corrientessocialclub.co.uk, opened its doors in the year 2000, its founders, Mina and Giraldo have developed a club which captures the atmosphere of traditional milongas mixed with more avant garde tango tendencies from Buenos Aires. The club has been visited by important tango artists: musicians, dancers and teachers such as the casts of TangoXDos and Tango Pasion, Miguel and Osvaldo Zotto, Lorena Ermocida, Pablo Veron, Mora Godoy, Natalia Games and Gabriel Angio and many other great artists from Nuevo tango and traditional tango including several milongueros from 'La Guardia Vieja'. The main thrust of Corrientes Social Club is to educate and delight UK audiences on the wonders of tango dance from Argentina.

It has a large number of professionally trained teachers (in house and guests) and practitioners keen to promote, perform and teach tango. The club produces an informative monthly programme and is constituted as a members club. We also promote Argentine tango on national tours with our dance company www.tiempodetango.com.



The club run activities at 2 main sites one at the Haverstock School in Chalk Farm, 2 Saturdays per month and the second at West Greenwich House in Greenwich, every Friday.

LONDON ROCKIN' ROLLERS

The London Rockin' Rollers (LRR) is an all-girl sports team, putting rock 'n' roll into roller derby. What is roller derby? Well, it is a fast-paced, full-contact, exciting game – on roller skates; the old fashioned quad skates, not the in-line skates, as they give you more stability and control. The LRR has been a team for more than two years. We meet twice a week to train – learning basic skating skills and more advanced roller derby techniques. We also need to be fit to skate as it is a very demanding sport.

Roller derby is a unique sport, there is nothing else like it. There are no balls or bats, only people. Both teams skate around an oval track. One person from each team wears a star on her head to show she is the Jammer – only the Jammer can score points. She gets a point for each member of the opposition she skates past, but the opposition is allowed to stop the Jammer skating past by blocking her or body checking her. It can be quite rough at times!



For a young team, the LRR has done very well. We have skated in bouts abroad and in 2009 have started holding our own bouts in London. The first one (Spring equiKNOCKS) was in March, where we narrowly lost to the Glasgow Irn Bruisers, and the most recent one (a Midsummer Night's Scream) was in June, where we beat the Royal Windsor Roller Girls. Our next bout (Great Brawls of Fire!) is on 5th September, against the Stuttgart Valley Rollergirlz, which will be a very difficult bout – but one that we can win!
